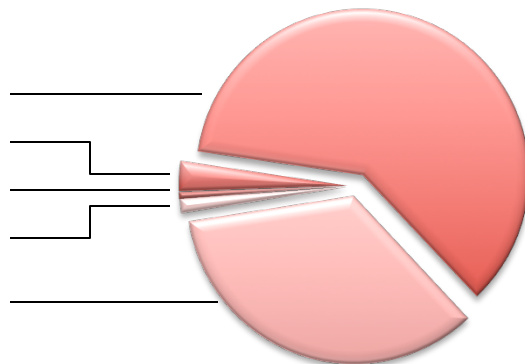

Lives affected in 2010

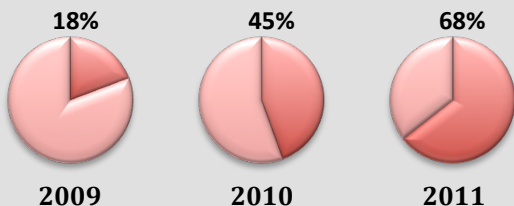

Economic

82 loans disbursed

Achievements – 16 new businesses created, 66 businesses funded with new capital. Repayment rate of 96% on outstanding loan portfolio. Return on investment of 10.4%.

Current Portfolio – 30 of 36 outstanding loans are currently one month or more ahead of repayment schedule.

Education

622 lives changed

Achievements – We finished construction of one of the largest public libraries in Liberia. It contains over 4,000 library books and 1,200 textbooks. We also continued with our student scholarship program and launched an adult literacy and numeracy training program.

Healthcare

13,505 people treated

Achievements – our clinic treats on average 35-40 patients each day.

Common Medical Issues (CMI) – Malaria, Acute Respiratory Infections, Gastro-Intestinal Disorders, and Malnutrition

Infrastructure

7,700 have clean water

Achievements - 4 wells built, 2 wells replaced, and 6 wells repaired in various villages within Lower Virginia.

Spiritual

294 lives impacted

Our pastor's conferences trained and mentored 250 pastors and church leaders within the Lower Virginia community. Our summer sports camp also mentored and impacted the lives of 44 young adults.
