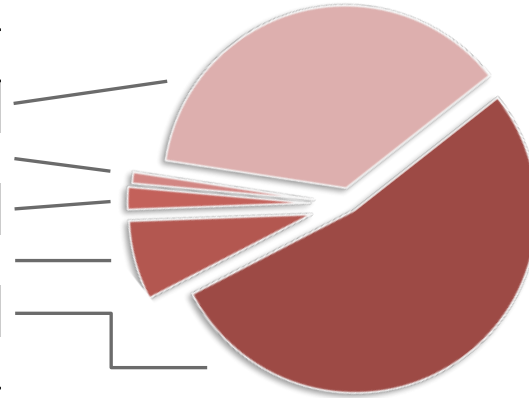

Lives Impacted In 2011

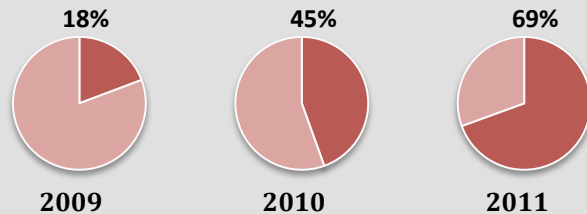

Economic

550 loans disbursed

We disbursed over \$27,000 of micro-loans in 2011. Through our micro-lending and business development program, over 50 new Liberian businesses were started. These businesses provide a sustainable source of income to 550 Liberians. Our current repayment rate stands at 96%.

Healthcare

18,678 people treated

This year we launched the Liberia Now pharmacy. So far, 8,022 Liberians have received low-cost medicines through our pharmacy and 10,656 people have been treated at our clinic.

Education

2,174 lives changed

This year we built 6 new libraries, stocking them with over 23,000 donated books. Additionally, we hosted teacher training seminars, continued our scholarship and adult literacy programs, and donated 10 telescopes to school science programs.

Spiritual

124 lives impacted

Many pastors currently serving in Liberia have a passion for God and for serving the church body. However, they often lack the resources and training needed to successfully lead a church. Our pastoral training program actively mentors and trains 40 pastors and church leaders within the Lower Virginia community. Additionally, 28 university-aged students went through discipleship training and several Liberians gave their lives to Christ through Liberia Now evangelistic outreaches.

Infrastructure

13,200 with clean water

We currently maintain a circuit of 18 water wells throughout Lower Virginia. These wells provide a clean and reliable source of water to Liberian residents.
