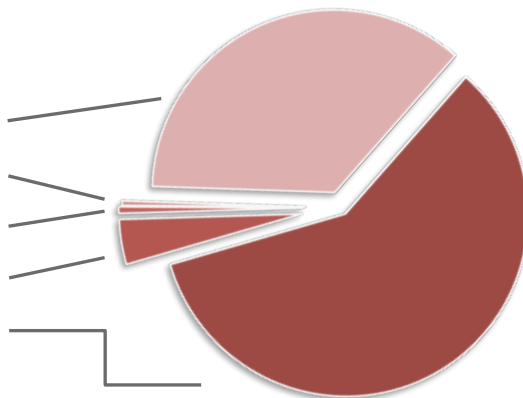

Lives Impacted in 2012

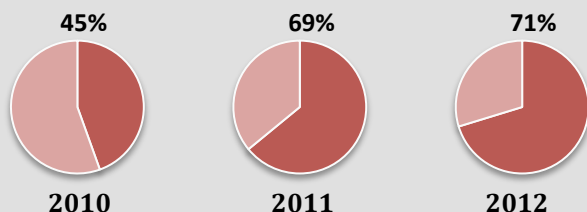

Economic

150 lives impacted

Through our micro-lending and business development program, 52 Liberian small business owners received micro-loans. These businesses provide a sustainable source of income to approximately 150 Liberians. Our current repayment rate stands at 86%.

Infrastructure

8,533 with clean water

We currently maintain 19 water wells throughout Lower Virginia. These wells provide a reliable source of water to Liberian residents. This year we completed construction on our 19th well, located in the refugee community of Brewerville. This new well now provides clean water to 700 residents currently struggling with several water-borne illnesses.

Education

2217 lives changed

This year we had 47 students as part of our scholarship program. While on scholarship, students receive free tuition & school supplies, while they are in school. Additionally, we hosted a two-week teacher training institute in July. Teachers from over seven schools took part in the program. There are also seven school libraries which Liberia Now established and oversees.

Healthcare

24,351 people treated

11,297 Liberians have received low-cost medicines through our pharmacy and 13,054x people have been treated at our clinic.

Spiritual

90 leaders mentored

In 2012, we hosted two separate pastoral training and leadership development conferences for 40 Liberian pastors. By choosing to equip and mentor these godly leaders, we are affecting the lives of hundreds of Liberians across several communities. Additionally, this year our discipleship program has worked with 50 high-school and college-age students. Our goal is to equip these young leaders to serve Christ and their communities through God's unique calling upon their lives.
